



NWT SPORT HALL OF FAME INDUCTION INFORMATION

A. THE SELECTION PROCESS:

- Nominations for Induction in the following calendar year are accepted until September 15.
- Any individual of association may submit a nomination with the following exceptions:
 - A current Member of the NWT Sports Hall of Fame Selection Committee may not submit a nomination.
 - A Member of the Sport North Board of Directors may submit a nomination but if the Director submits a nomination, that Director may not vote on that nomination if and when it is brought to the Board of Directors for approval.
- Each nomination is eligible for three (3) consecutive years. If at the end of the three (3) consecutive years of eligibility, a nomination has not been selected for induction, the nomination must sit inactive for a period of one (1) year after which the nomination can be resubmitted.
- All nominations will be considered at an initial Selection Committee meeting at the beginning of October. Depending on the outcome of that process, further information on the nomination may be required. The final selection process will take place at the beginning of November and the names will be released to the media in November.

B. CATEGORIES: Athlete, Builder and Team

C. SELECTION CRITERIA

1. ATHLETE:

- Any athlete who has attained a high level of excellence and brought recognition or honour to Northwest Territories sport on a national or international level in relation to participation in open level sport(s) competition.
- A NWT member of Canadian Team may stand for induction as an individual athlete.
- An individual is not eligible for nomination until three (3) years following retirement from open level sport(s) competition, except in the event of death or by winning an Olympic or a World championship gold medal whereby the nomination is eligible for immediate consideration.



- An individual retired for a period of three (3) years from open level sport(s) competition, but still competing in Seniors or Masters competition is eligible for consideration.

2. BUILDER: (including Referee, Coach and Administrator)

- Attained a high level of excellence and brought honour to Northwest Territories sport through ongoing dedication to the building of athletes, teams, or sport itself.

3. TEAM:

- Any team that has attained a high level of excellence and brought recognition or honour to Northwest Territories sport at a national or international level in relation to open level competition. Team members are recognized as part of a team and not as an individual Honoured Member.
- The NWT members of a Canadian Team, which has reached special excellence on a national or international level, may be nominated and inducted as a group in the Team category.
- Teams are selected for achievements in one year, not an era.
- A team is not eligible for nomination until three (3) years following the year which a team is nominated for except by winning an Olympic or a World championship gold medal whereby the nomination is eligible for immediate consideration.
